Background:	Anti-Rabbit IgG Antibody DyLight™488 generated in sheep detects rabbit IgG. Sec	reted as part

of the adaptive immune response by plasma B cells, immunoglobulin G constitutes 75% of serum immunoglobulins. Immunoglobulin G binds to viruses, bacteria, as well as fungi and facilitates their destruction or neutralization via agglutination (and thereby immobilizing them), activation of the compliment cascade, and opsonization for phagocytosis. The whole IgG molecule possesses both the F(c) region, recognized by high-affinity Fc receptor proteins, as well as the F(ab) region possessing the epitope-recognition site. Both heavy and light chains of the antibody molecule are present. Secondary Antibodies are available in a variety of formats and conjugate types. When choosing a secondary antibody product, consideration must be given to species and immunoglobulin specificity, conjugate type, fragment and chain specificity, level of cross-reactivity, and host-species source and fragment composition. This Anti-Rabbit IgG (H&L)

Assay by immunoelectrophoresis resulted in a single precipitin arc against anti-Sheep Serum, Rabbit IgG and Rabbit Serum. No reaction was observed against Bovine, Chicken, Goat, Guinea Pig, Hamster, Horse, Human, Mouse, Rat or Sheep Serum Proteins. This antibody will react with heavy chains of rabbit IgG and with light chains of most rabbit immunoglobulins.

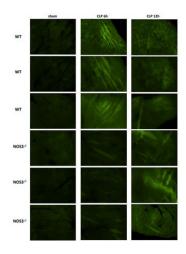
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Shipping & Handling

Shipping Condition:	Ambient		
Storage Condition:	Store vial at 4° C prior to restoration. For extended storage aliquot contents and freeze at -20° C or below. Avoid cycles of freezing and thawing. Centrifuge product if not completely clear after standing at room temperature. This product is stable for several weeks at 4° C as an undiluted liquid. Dilute only prior to immediate use.

Immunohistochemistry

Immunohistochemistry. NOS3 increases 3-nitrotyrosine content in heart tissue in developing sepsis. Immunohistochemical staining demonstrated an increase of nitrotyrosine in heart tissue of septic wildtype mice at 6 hours post CLP, whereas no differences could be detected in NOS3-/- mice.

Heart samples were fixed in 4% formaldehyde phosphate buffer, dehydrated and paraffin-embedded. For 3-nitrotyrosin detection serial sections (3 per mouse, 400µm apart) were incubated with a polyclonal antibody raised against nitrotyrosine, followed by sheep anti-rabbit IgG conjugated to DyLight™488 (p/n 611-641-122). 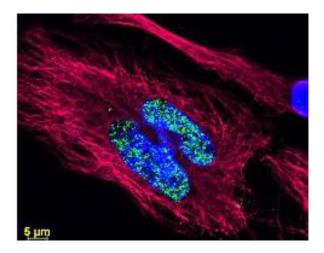

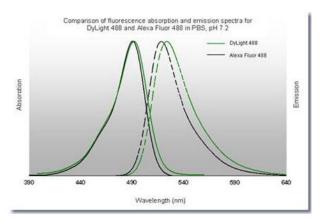
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Immunofluorescence Microscopy

This image shows anti-histone detection using a DyLight™ 488 conjugate (green). Anti-Tubulin was detected using a DyLight™ 549 conjugate (red). Nuclei were counter-stained using DAPI (blue). The image was captured using an Axio Imager.Z1 (Zeiss Micro Imaging Inc).
